About Bygone Walla Walla

The **BYGONE WALLA WALLA Project** is a local non-profit, non-commercial effort to build and share a visual history of Walla Walla.

What began as a retirement project in 2006 now has about 9,000 images in just over 1,000 topical posts on the blog. A new post and photo are added almost every day. The blog has hundreds of followers daily with well over a quarter-million views since its inception.

Bygone Walla Walla is a noncommercial effort to build a visual history of photos, maps, vintage ads, sketches, postcards and assorted memorabilia — just about anything that shows “the way it used to be around these parts.”
