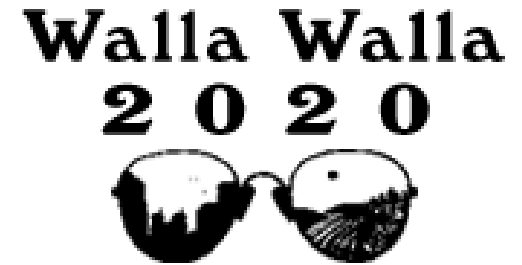

Historic Research & Plaque Project

In 1994, Walla Walla 2020 launched an historic building plaque and research project to help preserve Walla Walla's rich architectural and cultural history.

The purpose of the project has been to encourage people throughout the community to take pride in their neighborhoods, whether wealthy or humble, by honoring their history and buildings with handsome plaques.

We offer a distinctive, locally produced plaque of painted brass showing the date a structure was built, those who built or occupied it, and any other authenticated information of interest to the owner.

While the project places special emphasis on structures built before 1920, any building more than 50 years old that retains its

architectural integrity qualifies for both the plaque and the research project, which offers a basic search of Walla Walla County, Penrose Memorial Library and Pioneer Title Company records to assist in determining the date of construction and the owners of the property over the years.

The project has produced research reports and/or plaques for over 210 historic properties, including 150 residences and 60 commercial or institutional properties. A searchable list of the properties by address, construction date, and original building owner is available on the 2020 website, along with copies of the full reports, and an interactive map with the location and photo of all properties researched.

Honor a Walla Walla area building by obtaining a Walla Walla 2020 research report on its history

The project offers to research a residence for \$125, and a commercial building for \$200-300 depending on the property. In addition, a 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" seven-line plaque is available for \$50. Additional lines and sizes are also available.

Walla Walla 2020 research reports cover the property's history all the way back to when it was bare ground owned by local Tribes. Researched properties are also eligible to display a handsome plaque listing the date it was constructed, along with the names of its owners and builders.

Qualifying properties may be in any neighborhood, but must be at least 50 years old and have retained their architectural integrity.

For those properties accepted, a photo of the property along with the completed research report will be included in the Walla Walla 2020 Interactive Map of Historic Properties available online. Walla Walla 2020 will research the complete title and occupant history for accepted properties and provide a written report along with proposed plaque language.

Please note that preparation of a report and/or plaque by Walla Walla 2020 Historic Research & Plaque Service and inclusion in the Walla Walla 2020 Interactive Map of Historic Properties does not constitute the listing of the property on any official local/regional/national historic register. Application for such listings is in the discretion of the property owner.

Walla Walla 2020 Historic Research & Plaque Service reserves the right to decline any/all research requests it finds do not meet its program criteria.
